GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration and Student Information

Registration

You may register by phone, fax, email, online, or in person at our Provincial or Corner Brook Office. Class sizes are limited so early registration is advised.

Student Information

- Scent-free Policy: Students are asked to please respect our scent-free policy.
- Plan to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.
- Wear comfortable, casual clothing.

Certification

All First Aid courses are certified for three years. We recommend annual training and certification in CPR/AED.

Certificate Portability

Workplace first aid requirements can differ provincially and federally. If you require first aid certification from one jurisdiction to another, consult St. John Ambulance Provincial Office.

Upgrade from Emergency to Standard

You can upgrade from Emergency to Standard First Aid within three (3) months of successfully completing the Emergency First Aid Course.

Payment and Cancellation Policies

Payment Policy

All course fees are required to confirm your registration and seat(s) in class. Training programs are tax exempt. We accept cash, cheque, money order, Interac™ (debit), Visa and Mastercard.

Course Cancellation

St. John Ambulance reserves the right to cancel any classes that do not reach the minimum enrolment requirements or for extenuating circumstances. Every effort will be made to notify all registrants in a timely manner prior to class start date. Fees for cancelled classes by St. John Ambulance will be refunded in full or applied to another course upon request.

Student /Group Cancellations

Cancellations are non-refundable; however, we will gladly reschedule you to another course date. Cancellations or transfers must be requested prior to five (5) business days of the start of the course. Students failing to cancel or reschedule within five (5) business days will be charged a \$25 cancellation fee. For private group registrations, a company failing to cancel or reschedule within five (5) business days will be charged a \$135.00 cancellation fee (\$160 for Advanced courses).

BASIC FIRST AID AND CPR COURSES

Emergency First Aid (1 day)

Learn basic life-saving skills. Designed to help you recognize life-threatening emergencies and provide first aid until medical help arrives. CPR/AED training included.

Standard First Aid (2 day)

Includes the same basic life-saving skills as the Emergency First Aid plus a whole lot more. Designed to help you recognize and manage a wide range of emergencies until medical help arrives. CPR/AED training included.

Standard First Aid/HCP (2 day)

Intended for Health Care Providers, this course includes all the skills in Standard First Aid as well as CPR Level HCP.

Basic Rescuer CPR Level C/AED (1 day)

Resuscitation skills for Adults, Children and Infants. Annual recertification is recommended.

CPR Level HCP (1 day)

Specifically designed for the Health Care Professional, this course includes the skills required for Adult, Child and Infant Resuscitation; as well as proper use of the Bag Valve Mask (BVM) and AED training.

CPR/AED Recertification (½ day)

Designed for the individual who holds a current CPR Level C/AED or HCP/AED certificate and requires annual certification.



ADVANCED FIRST AID COURSES

Advanced Medical First Responder Level I (5 day)

This comprehensive, skills-oriented training program is designed for persons providing emergency pre-hospital care such as safety personnel, police, fire, and emergency response teams. Learn to handle medical and trauma-related emergencies as a first responder. CPR/AED training included.

Advanced Medical First Responder Level II (10 day)

This in-depth program prepares professional health and safety personnel to provide emergency and extended care in remote or high risk areas. CPR/AED training included.

EMR Ambulance (10 day)

This skills-oriented program is designed for persons charged with responding to medical and trauma-related emergencies and whose primary responsibility is emergency response. This program meets the (NOCP) National Occupational Competency Profile for EMR practitioners. Prerequisites: 18 years of age, Standard First Aid with Level HCP CPR.

MARINE FIRST AID COURSES

Marine Basic First Aid (2 day)

This course meets the Transport Canada training requirements for the Marine Basic First Aid program.

Marine Advanced First Aid (5 day)

This course meets the Transport Canada training requirements for the Marine Advanced First Aid program.

What Every Babysitter Should Know

Designed for youth aged 12-15, this course provides valuable information on caring for infants, toddlers and older children. Topics include basic First Aid, injury prevention and responsibilities of a mature babysitter.

Emergency Child Care

Designed for professional child care workers, but great for parents, grandparents and all caregivers involved with the care of children. This one-day course covers basic first aid skills and includes CPR training.

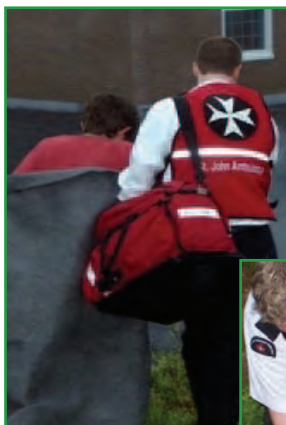

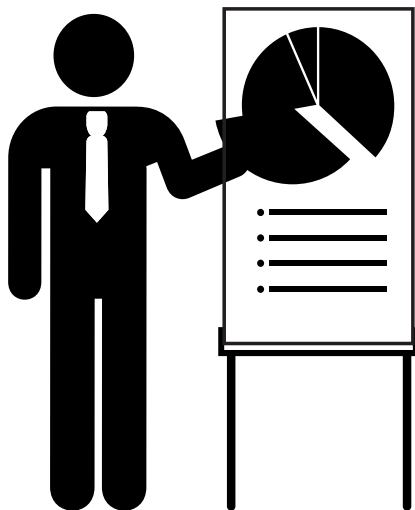

Health research indicates that returning to work as quickly and safely as possible is the best way to recover from a workplace injury. Even when workers have the same injury type, those who get back on the job quicker report better physical and mental health – and fewer limitations overall. Both workers and employers benefit from effective early and safe return-to-work (ESRTW) programs.

ESRTW Requirements

If your injury prevents you from performing your regular job duties, both you and your employer are required to work together to find suitable and available employment, even while you are receiving active medical treatment for your injury.
